1. How does Fletcher's understanding of himself change from the beginning of the story to the end? How do his goals change?
2. Do you think Arielle is a good partner for Fletcher? How might the story have been different if he were there alone?
3. Do you agree with Fletcher and Arielle's decision to rescue Ankhesenamen? Why or why not?
4. What things surprised you in this story?
5. Which character did you relate to the most? Why?
6. How do you think Fletcher would describe himself? What personality traits does he express? What is he clueless about?
7. What personality traits describe King Tut? What sort of ruler is he?
8. At what point in the story does Fletcher begin to change?
9. How does Ankhesenamen act as an ally to Fletcher and Arielle?
10. Describe Tut and Ankhesenamen's relationship. How do they feel about each other?
11. What is Tut's opinion of Fletcher, Arielle and Aye?
12. What did you like best about this story? What would you like to find out more about? Were there any parts that confused you?
13. How has your thinking about King Tut and ancient Egypt changed?
14. Which character did you find to be the most interesting and why?
15. Would you want to travel back in time to ancient Egypt? Why or why not?
